



Guidelines for Application

The impetus for creating this fund comes from the wish of her family and her teachers to commemorate the joyous part that dancing played in the life of Kaia Parker. We hope that our remembrance of Kaia can be expressed in helping other young dancers pursue their dreams and goals.

Guidelines:

1. Applicants must be between the ages of 12 and 18 years.
2. Funds may be used to pay tuition, transportation, or room and board for special courses of dance study or to support specific dance performances or projects. Funds are not to be used for the applicant's regular courses of study.

Requirements: Applicants must submit the following to: The Kaia Parker Fund for Young Dancers

1. A completed application form signed by the applicant and her/his parent or guardian.
2. A written proposal, up to two typed pages in length, outlining how the applicant will use the award and how s/he hopes the proposed activity will impact her/his future in dance. Plans must be specific.
3. A resume or brief list of previous dance study and performance experience.

Criteria: Applications will be judged as to the clarity of the proposal, the general merit of the project and the potential impact on the future of the applicant.

Deadline: All materials must be received at the above address by Wed, March 17, 2010. Auditions will be held on Saturday, March 20, 2010, 2 PM, at The Ballet School of Chapel Hill at the following address:

Photos: Please bring (or send with your application) a 5" x 7" headshot photo and advanced technique pose of some kind.

Dance Attire: Should be unencumbered classic dance wear (leotards and tights, or close fitting jazz pants, jazz shoes, point shoes for females with more than 1 year of pointe training). Hair should be neatly arranged back from your face and shoulders.

Warm Up and Audition: Please come prepared with a 2-3 minute solo in your strongest dance genre. We will provide a CD/tape player for your music (if relevant) and a short basic ballet warm-up beforehand for all dancers. Other spaces are available for those dancers from other genres who wish to practice on their own.

Awards:

1. Awards range from \$200 to \$1000. The number of awards given is determined by the availability of funds and the quality of applications.
2. Award recipients will be notified by May 1st.
3. Award recipients must submit a written evaluation of the funded project within 3 months from the time of completion. Copies are to be sent to Lee Glenn, Kaia's mother and founder of the Fund, at 1301 Blackwood Mt. Rd., Chapel Hill, NC, 27516. If the project includes a specific performance, we must be notified of the place, date and time in advance, and, if possible, a DVD of the performance must be submitted afterward.
